Jesus is God (A)	Genesis 1:1 and Collosian 1:15,16	Genesis 1:1: In the beginning, when God created the heavens and the earth... Collosian 1:15,16: He (Jesus) is the image of the invisible God , the firstborn of all creation. For in him were created all things in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers; all things were created through him and for him
	Matthew 1:23	"Behold, the virgin shall be with child and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means " God is with us "
	John 10:230	The Father and I are one
	John 1:1,2 and 1:14	John 1:1,2: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God . 1:14: And the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us, and we saw his glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth.
Holy Spirit is God (B)	Isiah 6:9,10 and Acts 28:25,26	Isiah 6:9,10: And He (the Lord) replied : Go and say to this people: Listen carefully, but you shall not understand! Look intently, but you shall know nothing! You are to make the heart of this people sluggish, to dull their ears and close their eyes; Else their eyes will see, their ears hear, their heart understand, and they will turn and be healed Acts 28:25,26: Without reaching any agreement among themselves they began to leave; then Paul made one final statement. "Well did the Holy Spirit speak to your ancestors through the prophet Isaiah, saying: Go to this people and say: You shall indeed hear but not understand. You shall indeed look but never see.
	Acts 5:3,4	But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart so that you lied to the Holy Spirit and retained part of the price of the land? While it remained unsold, did it not remain yours? And when it was sold, was it not still under your control? Why did you contrive this deed? You have lied not to human beings, but to God. "
	1 Corinthians 3:16	Do you not know that you are the temple of God , and that the Spirit of God dwells in you ?
Father is God ©	John 8:41	You are doing the works of your father!" (So) they said to him, "We are not illegitimate. We have one Father, God. "
	Ephesians 4:6	one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.
Only one God (D)	Mark 12:32	You are right in saying, ' He is One and there is no other than he.'
	1 Timothy 2:3,5	This is good and pleasing to God our savior, who wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth. For there is one God . There is also one mediator between God and the human race, Christ Jesus, himself human, who gave himself as ransom for all.
	1 Corinthians 8:4	So about the eating of meat sacrificed to idols: we know that "there is no idol in the world," and that " there is no God but one. "
	Isiah 45:5,7	I am the LORD and there is no other, there is no God besides me . It is I who arm you, though you know me not, so that toward the rising and the setting of the sun men may know that there is none besides me. I am the LORD, there is no other ; I form the light, and create the darkness, I make well-being and create woe; I, the LORD, do all these things.
